M.Sc. Nursing

Annual Intake : 50 seats (10 in each speciality)

Duration : 02 years

Eligibility :

- ▶ The candidate must have passed B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. (Honors) Nursing /Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks (50% in case of SC/BC/PWBD candidates).
- ▶ Must be a Registered Nurse or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- ▶ Must have a Minimum 1 (one) year of work experience from Hospital of a Recognized Medical College / Registered Hospital (registered with State Government) with minimum 100 beds. The work experience will be calculated from the date of registration in the respective Parent Council till the last date of submission of form. The experience attained both prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing shall be considered.

Selection of the candidate shall be on the merit basis through centralized counseling conducted by Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Science, Rohtak

B.Sc. Nursing

Annual Intake : 50 seats

Duration : 04 years

Eligibility :

- ▶ The minimum age for candidates desirous of seeking admission should not be less than 17 years as on 31.12.2023.
- ▶ The candidate must have passed Senior School Certificate examination (10+2) of Board of School Education, Haryana or any Board recognized by Central Government / any State Government with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English Core/English Elective and should have obtained at least 45% aggregate marks (40% marks for SC/BC/PWBD category) in Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English (PCB & E) taken together. However, the candidates should have obtained pass marks in each subject separately.

Selection of the candidate shall be on the merit basis through centralized counseling conducted by Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Science, Rohtak

Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing

Annual Intake : 50 seats

Duration : 02 years

Eligibility :

- ▶ The candidate must have passed Senior School Certificate examination (10+2) of Board of School Education, Haryana or any Board recognized by Central Government/Any State Government.
(i) Note: Those who have done Matric / 10+1 in or before 1986, will be eligible for admission.
- ▶ Should have passed GNM examination from any recognized Institute by INC and registered as GNM with any State Nursing Council.

Selection of the candidate shall be on the merit basis through centralized counseling conducted by Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Science, Rohtak

G.N.M. (for Male/Female only)

Annual Intake : 50 seats

Duration : 03 years

Eligibility :

Minimum Education:

- ▶ 10+2 class with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English Individually from any recognized board. Candidates from State Open School recognized by State government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government are also eligible.
- ▶ 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from school recognized by INC
- ▶ 10+2 with English having 40% marks in Vocational Stream – Health care Science from CBSE Board/Central Government.
- ▶ Registered ANM with pass marks.

Selection of the candidate is on merit basis through the online counseling by DMER, Panchkula

A.N.M. (for female only)

Annual Intake : 40 seats

Duration : 02 years

Eligibility :

Minimum Education:

- ▶ 10 + 2 in any stream (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, and Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Science or Health care Science - Vocational stream only passing out from recognized Board.
- ▶ Students qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science examination conducted by National Institute of Open School.
- ▶ The candidate should have obtained minimum passing marks/percentage as specified by the respective board.

MPHW (Male): Multipurpose Health Worker (male)

Eligibility :

Minimum Education:

- ▶ 10+2 with any stream (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, and Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Science or Health care Science - Vocational stream only passing out from recognized Board.
- ▶ Students qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science examination conducted by National Institute of Open School.
- ▶ The candidate should have obtained minimum passing marks/percentage as specified by the respective board.

EDUCATIONAL VISITS



The students are also being taken for educational visits to various places like HAU (HISAR), Red Cross Bhawan, Water and sewage treatment plants, milk plants, old age homes etc to complete their curriculum requirements and broaden their sphere of knowledge.

LIBRARY



The college has well ventilated and well maintained library with almost 3060 books in stock on nursing and allied subjects and is timely updated with new journals (National & International), magazines & books.

RULES & REGULATIONS

All the nursing students should comply with the following rules and regulations of the institute.

1. ACADEMIC RULES

- ▶ Students need to be punctual for theory classes and clinical practice according to the schedule given by the institution.
- ▶ Students have to submit all assignments exactly on specified dates except in genuine unavoidable circumstances with prior permission.
- ▶ No re-examination will be conducted for those who fail in the sessional examination.
- ▶ Re-examination of the sessional examinations will be conducted for the students who are absent due to sickness which is supported by authentic Medical Certificates or students who are absent because of some serious problems/needs at home which require their presence. This decision will be made by college authority.
- ▶ Students will be allowed to appear in the University examination in the subjects in which they have.
80% attendance of total number of theory classes taken.
80% attendance in the clinical experience hours in the clinical subject 20% of the clinical experience hours must be compensated before commencement of the next academic year. (As per the Indian Nursing Council regulations, 100% of the clinical experience hours have to be completed before starting the classes for the next higher class. The degree will not be granted unless and until 100% clinical experience hours are compensated during the stipulated period).
- ▶ Students are not allowed to use cell phones in the college premises, during the class hours or during the clinical experience hours. If found, the cell phone will be confiscated and fine will be imposed.
- ▶ Students must maintain discipline in the classroom and in the college premises so as to ensure a peaceful and conducive atmosphere for learning in the college.

2. LIBRARY RULES

- ★ Silence to be maintained.
- ★ No discussion permitted inside the library.
- ★ Registration should be done to become a library member prior using the library resources.
- ★ No personal belongings allowed inside the library.
- ★ Textbooks, printed materials and issued books are not allowed to be taken inside the library.
- ★ Using Cellular phones and audio instruments with or without speaker or headphone is strictly prohibited in the premises.
- ★ Show the books and other materials which are being taken out, to the librarian/to the staff at the entrance counter.
- ★ The librarian may recall book from any member at any time and the member shall return the same immediately. Library borrower cards are not transferable. The borrower is responsible for the books borrowed on his/her card.
- ★ Refreshment of any kind shall not be taken where in the library premises.
- ★ The books issued to students are supposed to be returned within a specified period otherwise a fine of Rs. 20/- per day will be charged.

3. HOSTEL RULES

Students are instructed to follow the following rules and regulations strictly.

1. Your rooms and hostel environment should be clean.
2. Be in time for your attendance at 9 P.M
3. Use the visitor's room for meeting the relatives.
4. Each student should submit the 3 photographs each of the responsible relative to the warden only such relatives will be allowed to meet the students.
5. Follow the visitor's hours as asked by the college rules- Sunday 10 am to 5 pm.

6. No Student is allowed to go hostel during college hours without getting proper permission.
7. Proper entries should be done in out pass book before leaving and entering the hostel
8. Proper discipline should be maintained in hostel and dining hall
9. All belongings should be kept under lock & key and management is not responsible for loss of robbery.
10. Students are not permitted to write, paste or hang anything on walls or doors.
11. Students should handle all the hostel equipments carefully. If anything is found to be damaged or missed the same has to be replaced by the students themselves.
12. Students are permitted to go home only on scheduled holidays (which will be intimated to the students).
13. Cell Phones are allowed only for a limited time as decided by the management.

Rules Regarding Anti Ragging

All the nursing students shall comply with the antiragging guidelines of the institute in force (As per UGC guidelines).

1. Any misconduct by any student is prohibited whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing or handling in hostel with rudeness neither in the college campus nor in hostel.
2. Any sort of authority, showing off power, or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student is prohibited and the culprit will be imposed with fine and strict action will be taken by anti ragging committee (which may include rustication of the culprit).
3. No student should be indulged in rowdy or indiscipline activities which can cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof, in any fresher or any other student.
4. No student is allowed to exploit the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
5. Report, any sort of such incident, immediately to the anti ragging committee and strict action will be taken against student culprit and his guilt act.
6. Anti ragging squad can visit the premises any time so as to look for healthy unhealthy environment in college and hostel.
7. All the anti ragging guidelines told during anti ragging counseling should be followed by students.
8. It is necessary for all the students and parents to submit an undertaking regarding anti ragging at the time of admission (as per format in the prospectus).

Besides above, the candidates would also observe the following instructions:

1. It must be noted by the candidates/parents/guardian etc. that ragging is banned in the institutions and in case anyone indulging in ragging is liable to be punished appropriately including expulsion from the institution and/or imprisonment up to 3 years, and/or fine up to 25000/-
2. The concerned institution will have the right that to prevent / prohibition of ragging under Act/Ordinance and if any, candidate admitted to the course found indulging in ragging will be cognizable offence and really means business and the institutes will not hesitate to take stern action against the offenders.
3. A candidate admitted to the course in an institution shall submit an undertaking duly signed by him/her and countersigned by his/her parents/ guardian at the time of admission to the effect that he/she is fully aware of the law regarding ragging as well as the punishment and that he/she if found guilty on this account is liable to be punished appropriately, As per the order of the Hon' ble Supreme Court of India dated 16.05.2007 which is reproduced below:

" If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel from the institution.

NOTE; Every student for the purpose of his/her admission shall furnish a character certificate from the institutions wherefrom he/she has passed his qualifying examination, which would mention the status of his/her behavioural pattern specially in terms as to whether he/she has displayed persistent, violent or aggressive behaviour or any desire to harm others.

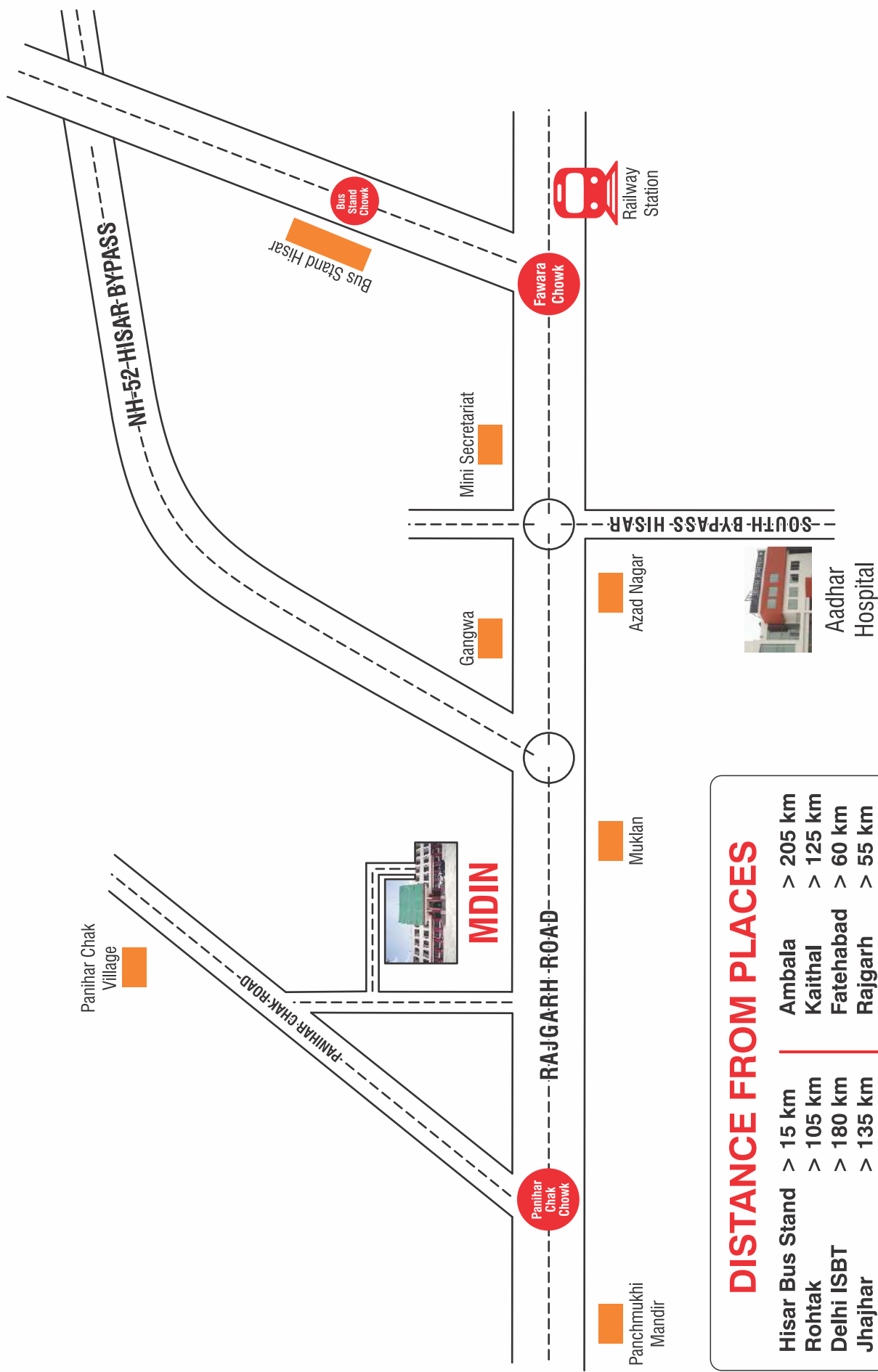
